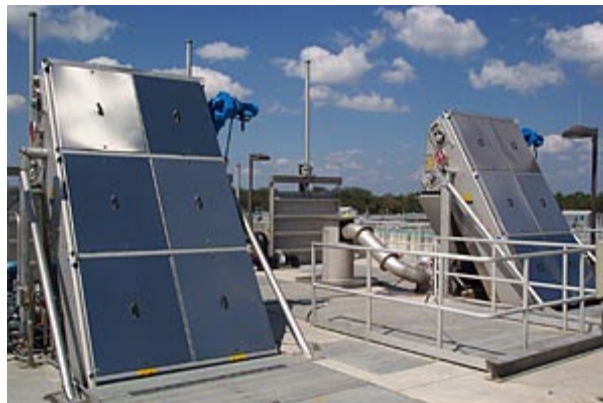


## Huber Technology Expands North American Headquarters

Huber Technology, Inc., a leading provider of wastewater treatment and filtration equipment, has expanded its U.S. headquarters, engineering and service operations. The company recently leased an additional 10,200 sq. ft. of flex space in NorthCross Business Campus, Huntersville. The transaction more than triples Huber's footprint in the park and accommodates growing demand for warehouse space and project management offices.

Sharon Thurner of Sonoma Commercial Properties represented Huber Technology in lease negotiations. The landlord was represented by Beacon Partners.

Huber Technology is a subsidiary of Hans Huber AG, a 137 year old manufacturer based in Berching, Germany. In addition to the manufacture of wastewater and filtration equipment, Huber is known widely as a world leader in water reuse research and development.

Huber Technology's sales, service and project management teams are involved in projects across the United States and Canada. The company has experienced rapid growth since its relocation in 2001 to Huntersville from Atlanta, where the company's U.S. roots began with five employees. Projected revenue for 2009 is \$20 million.

Huber currently employs 21 in Huntersville and earlier this year added a project manager and a service specialist to local headcount. By the end of 2009, the company expects to hire an additional project manager as well as a regional sales manager.

"Huber chose Mecklenburg County for our headquarters because it's a great location to do business," says Gerhard Forstner, President of Huber Technology. "Access to a skilled workforce, the presence of major educational institutions, the high quality of life, the cost of doing business and a major airport with two daily flights to Germany and many domestic direct flights were all extremely attractive to our company."
